
Opinión de los alumnos sobre el método Drama. /Students' opinions about Drama:

I didn't really had to learn that much so it was easy


Fueron bastante malos ya que no tenía mucha práctica.

Tienes cierta responsabilidad, porque debes interpretar bien, para que se entienda la obra y lo que estas contando


Its hard and sometimes I couldnt do it, but I tried

6. Did you have the feeling that drama enables you to act out / realize your creativity in lessons?


